


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
Part 1

Fabric Requirements		
Size of Appliqué Fabric	Appliqué Shape #	Fabric suggested color
18" x 4" 8" x 8"	Ground (1)	Fleece or Soft Machine Batting
18" x 4"	1	Green *
(2) 2" x 3"	2 & 2a	Dk Orange
2" x 4"; 2" x 3"	3 & 3a	Med Dk Orange
4" x 7"	4	Med Orange
5 ½" x 7"	5	Med Lt Orange
3 ½" x 5"	6	Green
2 ½" x 5"	7	Med Green
(5) 2" x 2 ½"	8 - 12	5 shades of Yellow

- 1) Hoop with sticky stabilizer.
- 2) Load design: **Oct Part 1**
- 3) Fold 24" x 20" background fabric in half, press, and in half again and press. Use a water soluble marker and measure 3" from intersection of crease down for first alignment.
- 4) Rotate background fabric 90 degrees and place on top of sticky stabilizer.
- 5) Attach hoop to embroidery unit.

**Align Background fabric to Crosshairs A and B**

- 6) Do not thread needle, make sure needle is in the center of Crosshair "A" on the screen.
- 7) Place the background fabric on top of the hoop.
- 8) On the Embroidery machine screen, make sure needle position indicator is located on the center of crosshair "A".
- 9) Move the background fabric so that the needle is inserted where the 3" drawn line and the vertical crease intersect. Gently press the fabric around the needle to lightly secure it to the sticky stabilizer. Raise needle.
- 10) Select Thread color "2" on the screen to forward needle to center of "B" crosshair, insert needle to confirm alignment. Press around the needle to secure the background fabric. Raise needle.
- 11) Remove hoop from embroidery unit and place it on a flat surface. Hand press the background fabric flat onto the sticky stabilizer. Return the hoop to the embroidery unit, recheck alignment for A and B Crosshairs.



**\*NOTE-** Piece 1 fleece and applique fabric will be stitched in both Part 1 and Part 2. Gently move and pin the excess fleece and applique fabric away from the other applique shapes in Part 1.

3 – Placement; 4 – Tack Down	Fleece for piece 1	Placement Stitches (P) for Fleece. After Tack Down (TD) remove hoop from embroidery unit and <b>TRIM</b> the Fleece using the Tack Down stitch as a guide. <b>NOTE: the fleece or batting will be longer than the tack down stitch, as it will continue onto Part 2.</b>
5 – Placement; 6 – Tack Down 7 – Underlay Stitch 8 – Trapunto Stitch 9 – Cover Stitch	1	<b>TRIM</b> applique fabric after Tack Down Stitch. <b>Note the Applique fabric will be the full length of the block. Just trim to the end of the Tack Down Stitch. Pin the fleece and applique fabric out of the way for the rest of the applique pieces for Part 1.</b> Underlay Stitch is a small ZZ to secure the applique fabric. Use thread color to match applique fabric or cover stitch. Use a contrasting thread color for Trapunto Stitch. Change thread color for Cover stitch (feather stitch) to match Applique fabric
10 – Placement; 11 – Tack Down	Fleece for Pumpkin, Leaf,	Placement Stitches (P) for Fleece. After Tack Down (TD) remove hoop from embroidery unit and <b>TRIM</b> the Fleece using the Tack Down stitch as a guide.
12 – Placement; 13 - 14 – Tack Down 15– Underlay Stitch	2 & 2a	<b>TRIM</b> applique fabric after Tack Down Stitch. Underlay Stitch is a small ZZ to secure the applique fabric. Use thread color to match applique fabric or cover stitch.
16 – Placement; 17 - 18 – Tack Down 19– Underlay Stitch	3 & 3a	<b>TRIM</b> applique fabric after Tack Down Stitch. Underlay Stitch is a small ZZ to secure the applique fabric. Use thread color to match applique fabric or cover stitch.
20 – Placement; 21 – Tack Down 22 – Underlay Stitch	4	<b>TRIM</b> applique fabric after Tack Down Stitch. Underlay Stitch is a small ZZ to secure the applique fabric. Use thread color to match applique fabric or cover stitch.
23 – Placement; 24 – Tack Down 25 – Underlay Stitch	5	<b>TRIM</b> applique fabric after Tack Down Stitch. Underlay Stitch is a small ZZ to secure the applique fabric. Use thread color to match applique fabric or cover stitch.

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

36 – Trapunto Stitch	6,7	Use a contrasting thread color for Trapunto Stitch.
37 – Cover Stitch	6,7	Change thread color for Cover stitch (feather stitch) to match Applique fabric
38 – Placement; 39 – Tack Down	8	<b>TRIM</b> applique fabric after Tack Down Stitch.
40 – Placement; 41 – Tack Down	9	<b>TRIM</b> applique fabric after Tack Down Stitch.
42 – Placement; 43 – Tack Down	10	<b>TRIM</b> applique fabric after Tack Down Stitch.



- 1) Hoop with sticky stabilizer.
- 2) Load design: **Oct Part 2**
- 3) Place Background fabric on top of sticky stabilizer.
- 4) Attach hoop to embroidery unit.

**Align Background fabric to Crosshairs A and B**

- 5) Do not thread needle, make sure needle is in the center of Crosshair "A" on the screen.
- 6) Place the background fabric on top of the hoop.
- 7) On the Embroidery machine screen, make sure needle position indicator is located on the center of crosshair "A".
- 8) Move the background fabric so that the needle is inserted into the center of Stitched Out Crosshair A. Gently press the fabric around the needle to lightly secure it to the sticky stabilizer. Raise needle.
- 9) Select Thread color "2" on the screen to forward needle to center of "B" crosshair, insert needle to confirm alignment. Press around the needle to secure the background fabric. Raise needle.
- 10) Remove hoop from embroidery unit and place it on a flat surface. Hand press the background fabric flat onto the sticky stabilizer. Return the hoop to the embroidery unit, recheck alignment for A and B Crosshairs.

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

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

**Align Background fabric to Crosshairs A, C and D.**

5. Do not thread needle, make sure needle is in the center of Crosshair "A" on the screen.
6. Place the background fabric on top of the hoop.
7. On the Embroidery machine screen, make sure needle position indicator is located on the center of crosshair "A".
8. Move the background fabric so that the needle is inserted into the center crosshair "A". Gently press the fabric around the needle to lightly secure it to the sticky stabilizer. Raise needle.
9. Select Thread color "2" on the screen to forward needle to center of "C" crosshair, insert needle to confirm alignment. Press around the needle to secure the background fabric. Raise needle.
10. Select Thread color "3" on the screen to forward needle to center of "D" crosshair, insert needle into vertical crease to confirm alignment. Press around the needle to secure the background fabric. Raise needle.
11. Remove hoop from embroidery unit and place it on a flat surface. Hand press the background fabric flat onto the sticky stabilizer. Return the hoop to the embroidery unit, recheck alignment for Crosshairs A, C and D.


