Tips for Cutting Shapes using a cutting Machine

- 1. First cut the fusible to the size indicated below and write the Applique Shape # on the paper side.
- 2. Iron fusible to backside of fabric and trim about 1/4" all around.
- 3. Place fabric side down on cutting mat; make sure the shape is mirrored before cutting.
- 4. Write the Applique Shape # on the paper side if it was cut away.
- 5. Place all shapes in a baggy until ready to stitch out design on embroidery unit.

Note: The embroidery file will have both the Placement and Tack Down steps.

After the Placement Stitch, remove the hoop from embroidery unit and press the cut applique shape within the Placement Stitches. Make sure the Placement Stitches are covered.

Initiate the Tack Down stitch to secure the cut applque shape. If there is excess fabric beyond the Tack Down stitch, trim as needed.
