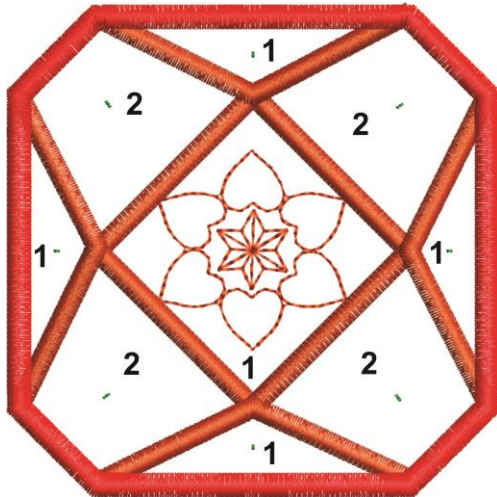


## Ornament 5 – Advent Santa

### Stitch out Instructions

Fabric Requirements	
Size of Appliqué Fabric	Appliqué Shape #
4 ½"	Ribbon for Ornament
(2) 4" x 4"	Med Cut Away Stabilizer
4" x 4"	Backing Fabric
4" x 4"	1
4" x 4"	2

#### **General Block Preparation Instructions:**

***The 2 pieces of Med Cut Away Stabilizer will remain inside the ornament to provide stiffness.***

- 1) Hoop with Wash Away Stabilizer.
- 2) Load design: **Ornament 5**
- 3) Follow stitch out instructions.

Stitch Order Ornament 5		
Step # and Stitch Type	Appliqué Shape #'s	General Instructions
1 – Placement Stitch 2 – Tack Down	1	Stitch out the Placement Stitch on top of the Wash Away Stabilizer. Place <i>Med Cut Away Stabilizer</i> and <i>Fabric 1</i> on top of the Placement Stitches. Fabric side up. Tack down fabric 1. After Tack Down (TD) remove hoop from embroidery unit and <b>TRIM</b> the fabric and Med Cut Away Stabilizer using the Tack Down stitch as a guide.
3 - Placemwnt 4 – Tack Down	2	Tack down fabric 2. After Tack Down (TD) remove hoop from embroidery unit and <b>TRIM</b> the fabric using the Tack Down stitch as a guide.
5 – Decorative Stitch		Change thread color as desired
6 - Crystal placement		NOTE: If planning to put crystals on the ornament, stitch out this color change to mark locations for crystals. If not using crystals, then skip this step.
7 – Tack Down		Tape a ribbon loop on the <b>BACK</b> of the hoop within the ornament for hanging. It should extend 1-1/4" above the edge of the ornament. Tape <i>Med Cut Away Stabilizer</i> and <i>Backing Fabric</i> on the <b>BACK</b> of the hoop, fabric right side up. Return hoop to embroidery unit and stitch Tack Down to secure Backing Fabric. Remove hoop and turn over to TRIM Backing Fabric.
8 – Cover Stitch		Match top and bobbin thread for Satin Stitch within the ornament.
9 – Cover Stitch		Change thread color (both top and bottom, if needed, for the Satin Stitch for outside edge of Ornament.
